Evidence

All references are to documents held by the County Record Office

- 1) St Nicholas Inclosure Award 1773 (QS75/123): states that all rights of way through the (then) St Nicholas Meadow were to remain. (The land was not enclosed)
- 2) Extinguishment Order 1818 (CR1618/W7/46): whole route shown on plan, together with route applied to be closed.
- 3) Warwick and Learnington Branch Railway (No.1) 1839 (QS111/114): shows route from Banbury Road on enlarged plan, but Book of Reference makes no mention of paths anywhere, or this track in particular: labels parcel as "pasture" of Earl of Warwick
- 4) Birmingham and Exford Junction Railway deviation Learnington to Warwick 1847 (QS111/200) deposited railway plan: shows and labels parcels 37, 39-43 as "footway" owned by the surveyor of highways
- 5) Other deposited railway plans (QS111/196 + /199): are similar to /200
- 6) Board of Health Map 1851: shows whole route
- 7) land acquired for Park under Warwick Corporation Act 1928 (18+19 George V Chapter 35)
- 8) Deposited plan of land for above park (QS111/628(part)) 1927: shows all paths, with ownership boundary, and labelled "taken from OS map"
- 9) Whole route shown as adopted/maintainable on Highway Authority plans
