

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 194, SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS N17 & N50, GALLEY
COMMON, NUNEATON**

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order details as indicated below:

Description of Order	Public Footpaths N17 & N50, Galley Common, Nuneaton closed to all traffic.
Reason for Order	to avoid the likelihood of danger to the public because works were being or were proposed to be executed on or near to the footpaths.
<p>The Order commenced on 26 October 2018 for a period of 6 months but was extended under direction of the Secretary of State until 25 October 2019.</p> <p>However, The Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has now directed that the Order shall continue in force until <u>25 April 2020</u> or until the works to which it relates are completed, whichever is the earlier (unless The Secretary of State issues a further direction).</p>
