

Summary of Temporary Road Layout Changes in Response To COVID-19:

Stratford-upon-Avon



The scheme includes:

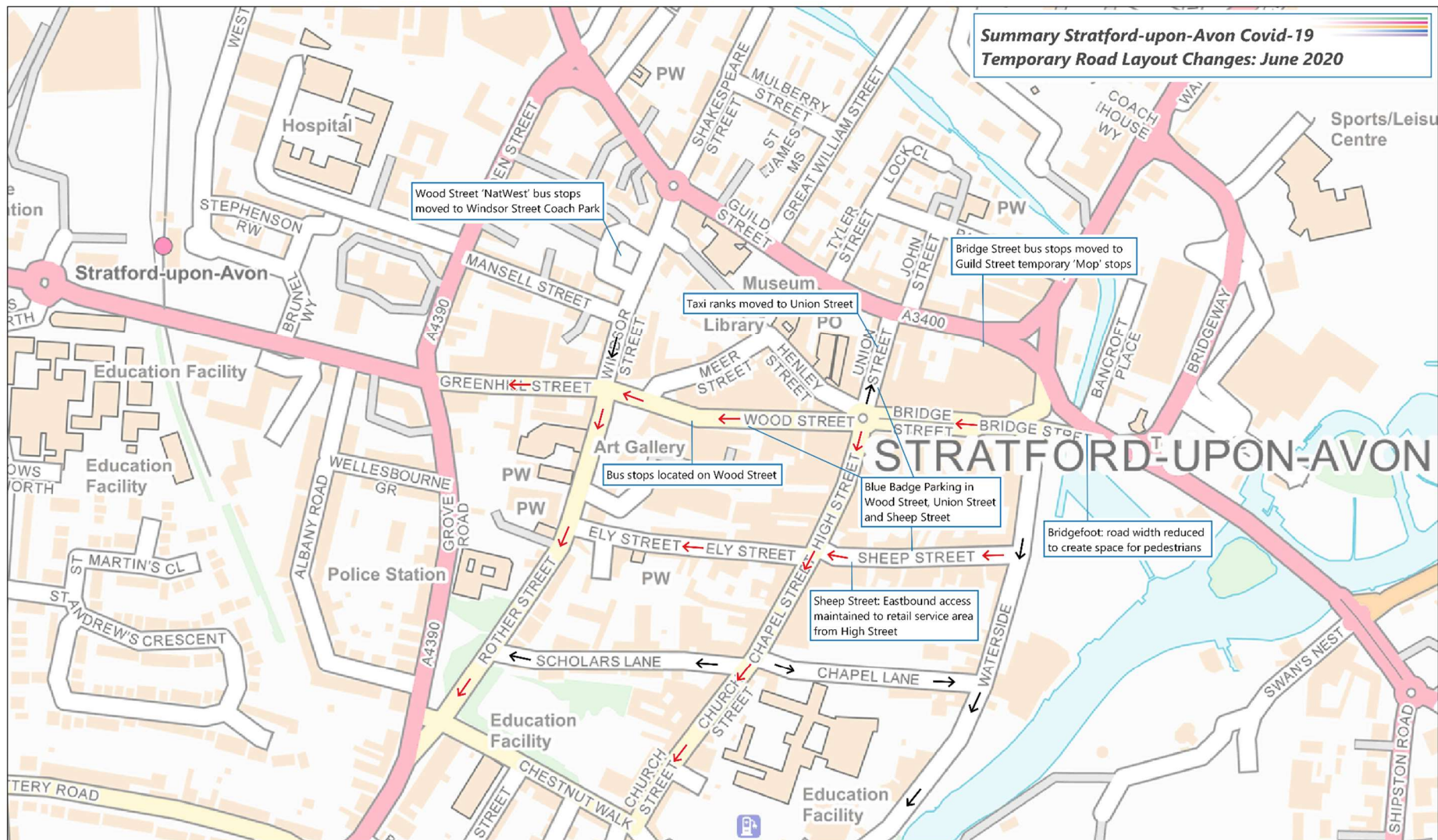
- **One-way traffic flows:**
 - Bridge Street, Wood Street, Greenhill Street will be closed to eastbound traffic.
 - Rother Street, High Street, Chapel Street and Church Street will be closed to northbound traffic.
 - Sheep Street will be closed to eastbound traffic (with access maintained from High Street to the retail service area).
- **Alcester Road:** Two-way traffic permitted throughout. Town centre bound traffic permitted to turn left onto Arden Street and right onto Grove Road.
- **Cycle lane:** Cycle lane provided for cyclists travelling eastbound on Bridge Street.
- **On-street parking suspension:** Some town centre on-street parking will be suspended. Visitors are advised to use car parks and avoid driving into or through the town centre.
- **Blue badge parking:** Parking for blue badge holders will be provided in:
 - Union Street.
 - Wood Street, which will have a small number of spaces.
 - Sheep Street.
 - Henley Street where the existing blue badge parking at the top of Henley Street is retained.
- **Speed limit:** A 20mph speed limit across the town centre
- **Pedestrian crossings:** Changes to pedestrian crossings to create more space and time for pedestrians.
- **Taxi ranks:** Town centre taxi ranks at Union Street outside Lloyds Bank and Wood Street outside Natwest Bank.
- **Bus stops:**
 - Wood Street 'Natwest' bus stops are being relocated to Windsor St Coach Park.
 - Bridge St bus stops have been moved to the temporary 'Mop' stops on Guild St.
 - The westbound stops on Wood Street are retained.
- **Bridgefoot carriageway narrowing:** Additional space created for pedestrians on Bridgefoot by removing a lane of traffic
