1	Templar Court	Various parking issues	A multiagency meeting to address this is planned for July
2	Wem brook South Neighbourhood Watch	Request Police presence at next meeting	Police agreed to attend future meetings
3	Various locations	KEEP CLEAR signs opposite Council House and Henry Street need re-painting	A works instruction has been issued to recover the road markings on Coton Road from Roanne Ringway roundabout to Coventry Road, this will include the KEEP CLEAR marking outside the Council House. The work will be carried out in the next 2 months. Henry Street is programmed to be resurfaced in September this year and all existing road markings will be replaced following that week.
4	Various locations	GIVE WAY signs need re-painting – Fife Street, Duke Street, Mount Street near junction with Queens Road	A works instruction has been issued to our contractor to recover the road markings in the Queens Road, Edward Street and Duke Street area this will include the Give Way markings mentioned. The works should be carried out in the next 2 months.
5	Dugdale Street	Wall needs repairing following collision	WCC to repair
6	Riverlsey Park Tunnel	When will the mural be completed?	Artwork has been completed
7	Riversley Park	Asking for an explanation/rationale of some of the recent works in the park	Please see attached update
8	Pingles Barrier	Barrier has been left insecure allowing illegal access to the car park	This will be secured
9	Pingles Track	Benches and bins not replaced on the path adjacent to the track connecting two tunnels	Please see attached update
10	Recycle Bins	Can we have feedback in 6 months to learn about contamination levels since the leaflet has been posted to residents	This will be feedback at the September Forum
11	College Street	Speeding - can speed-watch scheme be implemented?	These are managed direct by Warwickshire Police via the Safer Neighbourhood Teams.
12	Caldwell area	Residents unhappy with quality of litter collection across the area	This has been flagged in other areas also and raised with the contractor responsible
13	Bradestone Road	Pot holes need	A works instruction has been issued to our contractor to fill the potholes, we expect this to be completed within the next 3 weeks.

<b>14</b>	Morris Drive, Caldwell and Donithorne Avenue	HGV using roads on a regular basis – can weight restriction signs be put up	Area has been audited and signs will be adjusted or replaced.
<b>15</b>	Update on Town Centre regeneration programmes	Abbey Street and Vicarage Street Developments	<p>Progress with both the Abbey Street and Vicarage Street regeneration schemes have been delayed due to national changes and uncertainty in the retail sector generally. The Abbey Street scheme as originally envisaged, included a large food store as the anchor, and this has been affected by changes in fortunes for the major supermarket chains.</p> <p>There is however, continued interest in investment in both schemes and alternatives are being considered, including live discussions with Marks &amp; Spencers Simply Food in relation to Abbey Street.</p> <p>Negotiations for both schemes are subject to commercial confidentiality, so no further details can be shared at present.</p>
<b>16</b>	Shop options for Poppy appeal	Are there units in the town centre that could be used the annual Poppy appeal	All NBBC units have been let – local agents have been asked as whether they can assist
<b>17</b>	Parking impact resulting from Coop funeral care	Concerns in relation to parking	No complaints have been made directly however they ask customers to use car parks in the local vicinity and have some spaces for immediate family on site
