Parking along Ash Green Lane	Refer to the Civil Parking Enforcement Team
Crates from the back of the One Stop Shop on Smorrall Lane – are being taken over to the balancing lakes on Smorrall Lane and burnt	To report to Environmental Health to advise the shop regarding safe and secure storage of their crates
Smorrall Lane balancing lake – the Council owned hedge which runs behind properties is overgrown and weakening the home owners own fence	Refer to Parks Team, NBBC
The Greens estate in particular the road of The Oaks – shrubbery is very over grown and full of weeds.	Refer to Parks Team, NBBC
Astley Lane (known locally as Rabbit Lane) fly tipping on the entrance to field before the care home and the T-junction	Report to Environmental Health, NBBC
