



## Veterans' Mental Health Transition, Intervention and Liaison Service

### Veteran Mental Health Support

If the veteran is not in immediate crisis and is seeking some mental health support they can ring the TILS referral line on 0300 323 0137 (9am-9pm). Professionals can also ring on their behalf but they **DO** need to gain the veterans consent to do so.

It is also worth advising the veteran to seek support from their GP.

Advise veteran to self-present at A/E where they will be seen by the mental health team.

Contact 999/111 if urgent – West Midlands Police/ Warwickshire Police have access to street triage mental health officers out of hours, who are also aware of Veterans and the mental health support available.

If professionals are concerned about the safety/whereabouts of a veteran and have legitimate concerns around their risk, you can contact the police to ask for a safe and well check.
