





## Here are the **PREVIOUS ACTIONS** taken away by Police

Bailey Park Issues may have quietened down but they have not gone away, drugs are smoked in bus shelter around 6.45ish. Police replied that a full visual audit was conducted and Council and Police agreed not to move the shelter as that might only move the problem. ACTION Contact Phil Richardson for a response, ACTION: Police will send plain clothes police to the area.

Parking in King Street opposite the off licence is hazardous and could be dangerous. ACTION: Police to ask colleagues to put on their patrol when in the area.

Park Road had 16 cars parked on double yellow lines on 10<sup>th</sup> Feb at 12.45. Police did not receive any reports. Residents are advised to persevere and call even though it is a bit of a wait.

## **Update on Actions:**



## Bailey Park:

- Operation carried out over several days, using plain clothes/cars & uniform.
- Operation also focussed on Child Criminal Exploitation (CCE), Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE), County Lines, Missing Persons, Intelligence gathering, Youth Referrals, and more.
- Operation involved Stop Searches / Encounters. A significant quantity of Searches carried out, and even more encounters recorded on Police systems.
- Operation involved other known/identified Hot Spot locations

Parking in King Street:



- Local Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT) are continuing to monitor the location where possible.
- Local Business Owners have been approached by PCSO and advised.
- Local PCSO has challenged several vehicles parking inconsiderately.
- <u>NOT one</u> parking incident recorded by residents with Police since last Forum.


### Parking in Park Road:

- ONE call logged with Police in 5 months.
- ONE vehicle seized by Police.



# **Operation Learner Traffic Op - Bedworth**:

- Student officers, SNT and others A Traffic Stop operation on Winding House Lane, Longford on 24th June 2019.
- 103 Vehicles brought on site
- 2 vehicles seized for No Tax
- 1 Foreign Vehicle seized for No Tax
- 2 vehicle seized Sec 165
- 13 TOR's issued for a number of motoring offences
- 1 driver reported for being overweight (the vehicle not the driver!)
- 7 VDR's issued
