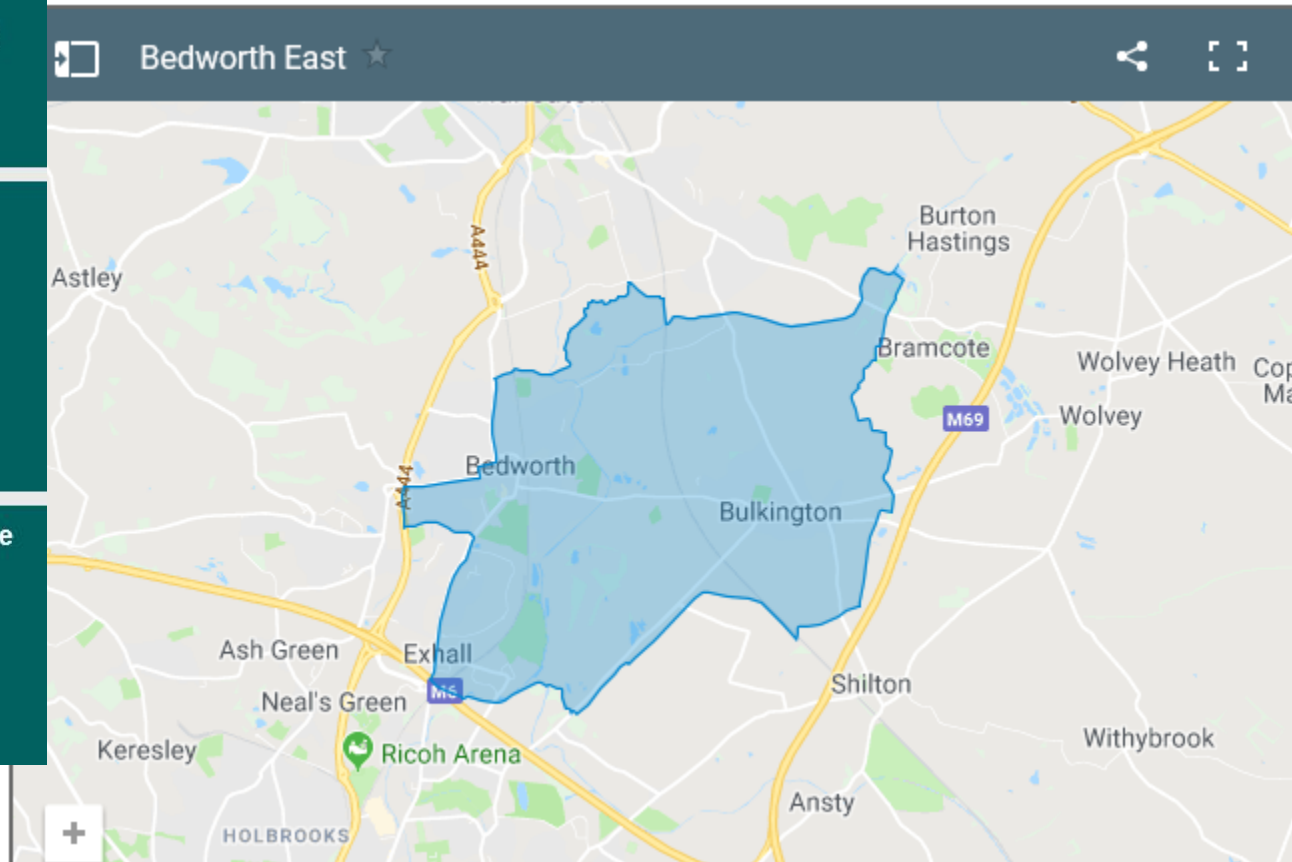

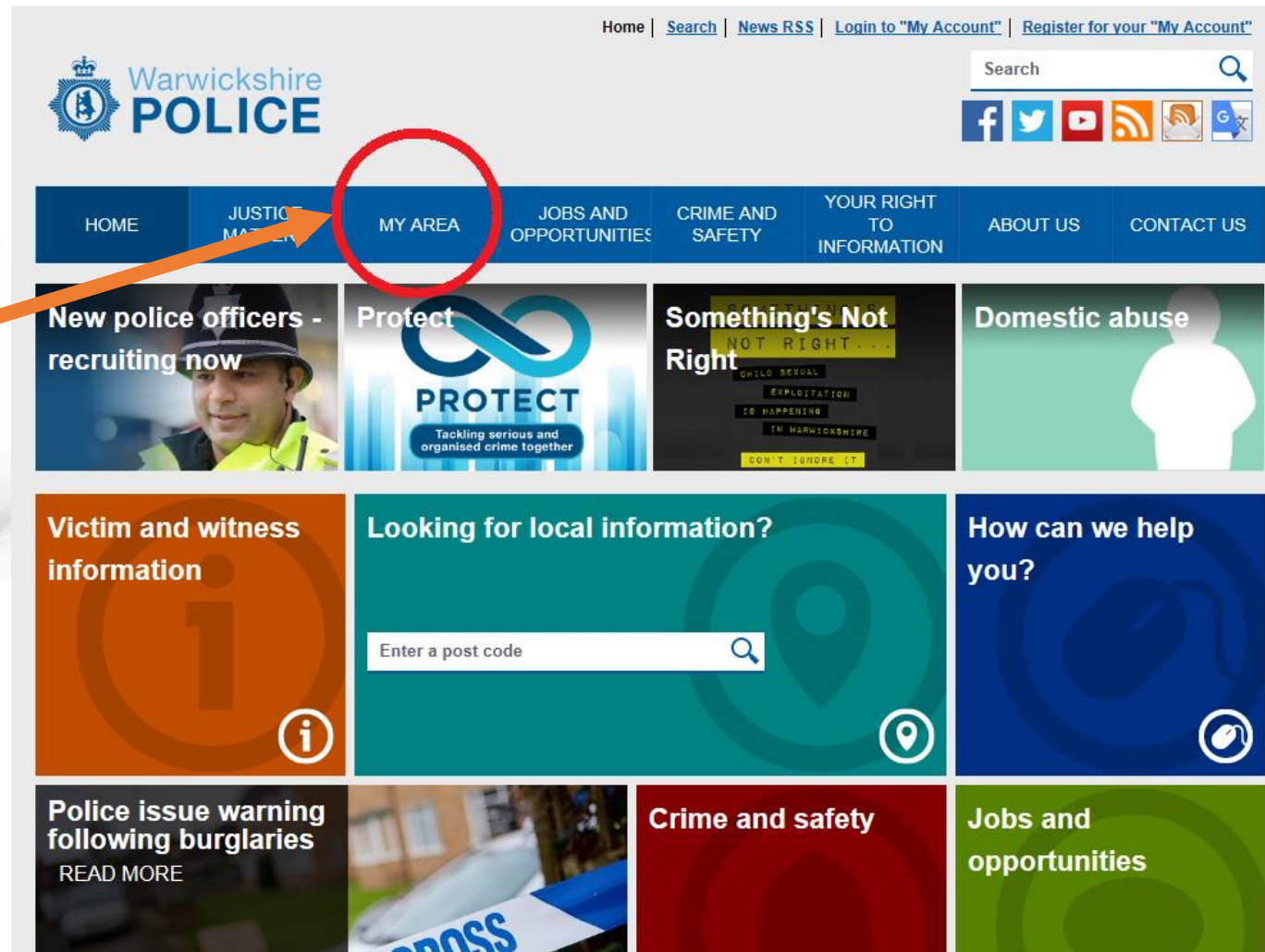

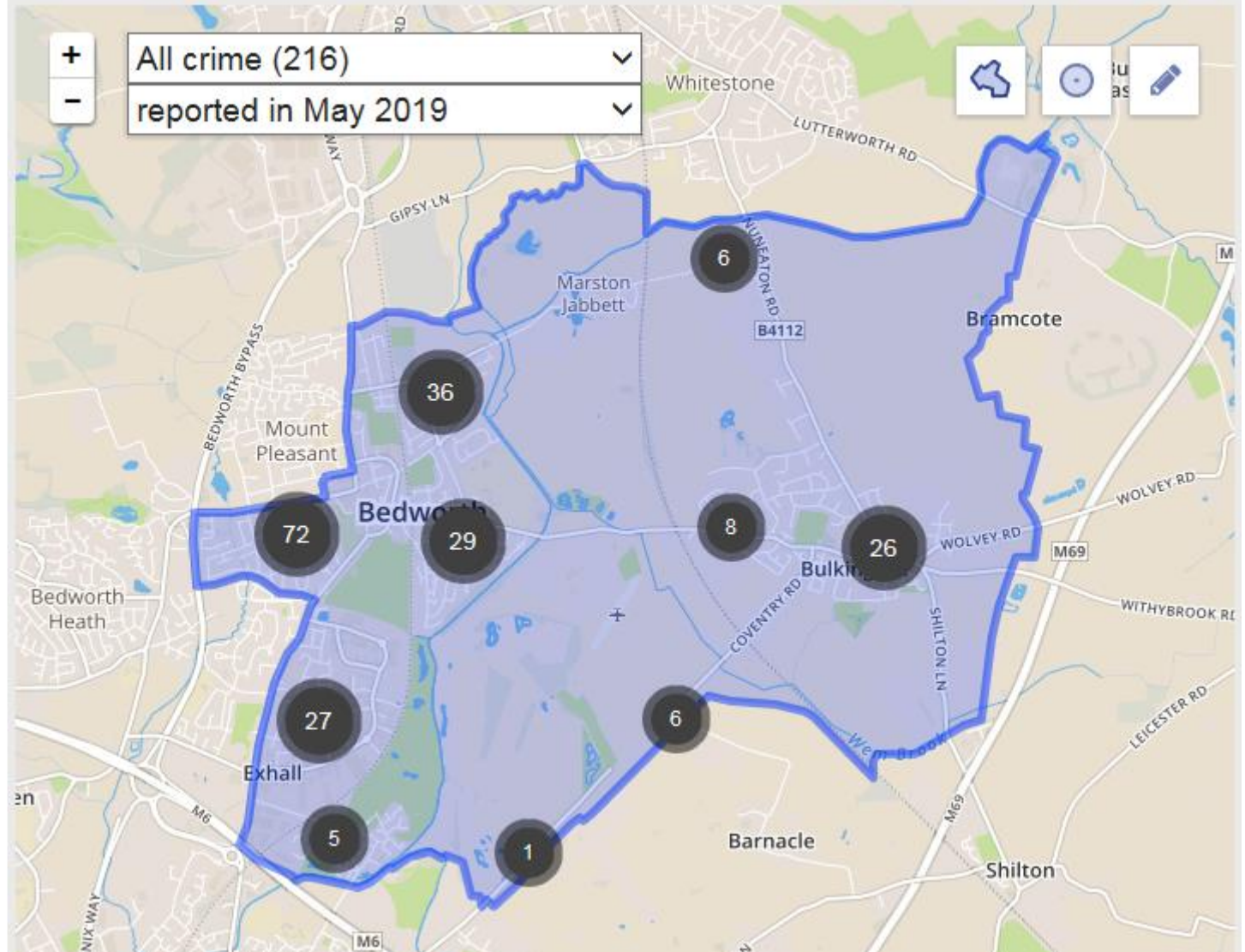

Bailey Park Issues may have quietened down but they have not gone away, drugs are smoked in bus shelter around 6.45ish. Police replied that a full visual audit was conducted and Council and Police agreed not to move the shelter as that might only move the problem. **ACTION Contact Phil Richardson for a response, ACTION: Police will send plain clothes police to the area.**

Parking in King Street opposite the off licence is hazardous and could be dangerous. **ACTION: Police to ask colleagues to put on their patrol when in the area.**

Park Road had 16 cars parked on double yellow lines on 10th Feb at 12.45. Police did not receive any reports. Residents are advised to persevere and call even though it is a bit of a wait.

Update on Actions:



Bailey Park:

- Operation carried out over several days, using plain clothes/cars & uniform.
- Operation also focussed on Child Criminal Exploitation (CCE), Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE), County Lines, Missing Persons, Intelligence gathering, Youth Referrals, and more.
- Operation involved Stop Searches / Encounters. A significant quantity of Searches carried out, and even more encounters recorded on Police systems.
- Operation involved other known/identified Hot Spot locations

Parking in King Street:

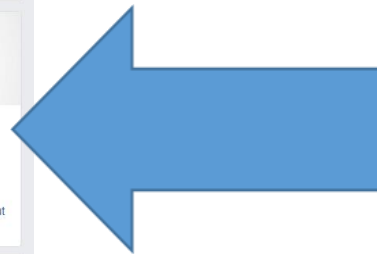
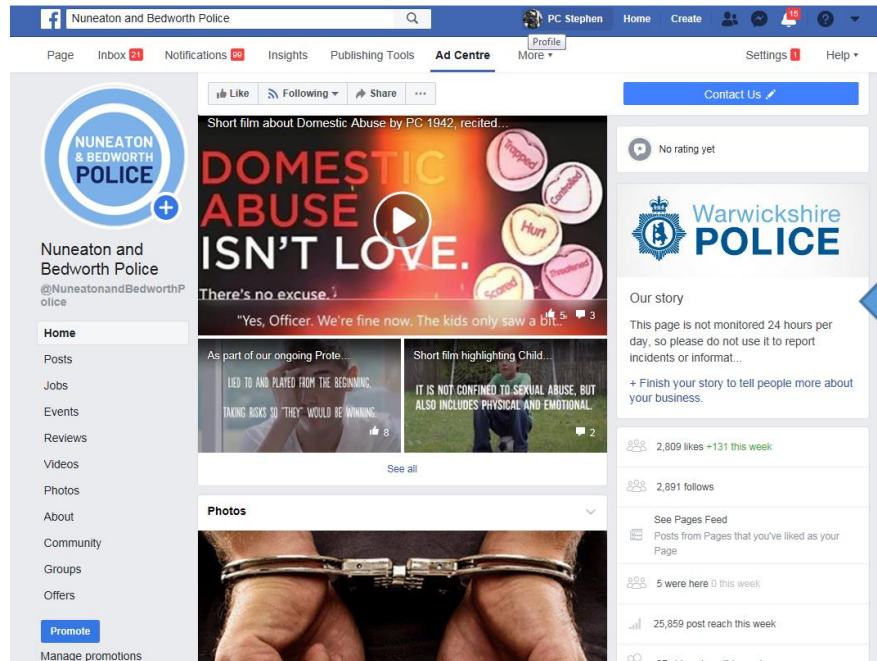
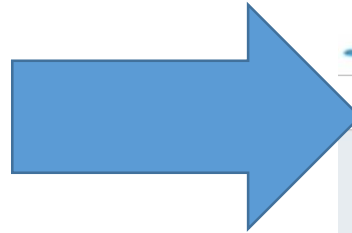
- Local Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT) are continuing to monitor the location where possible.

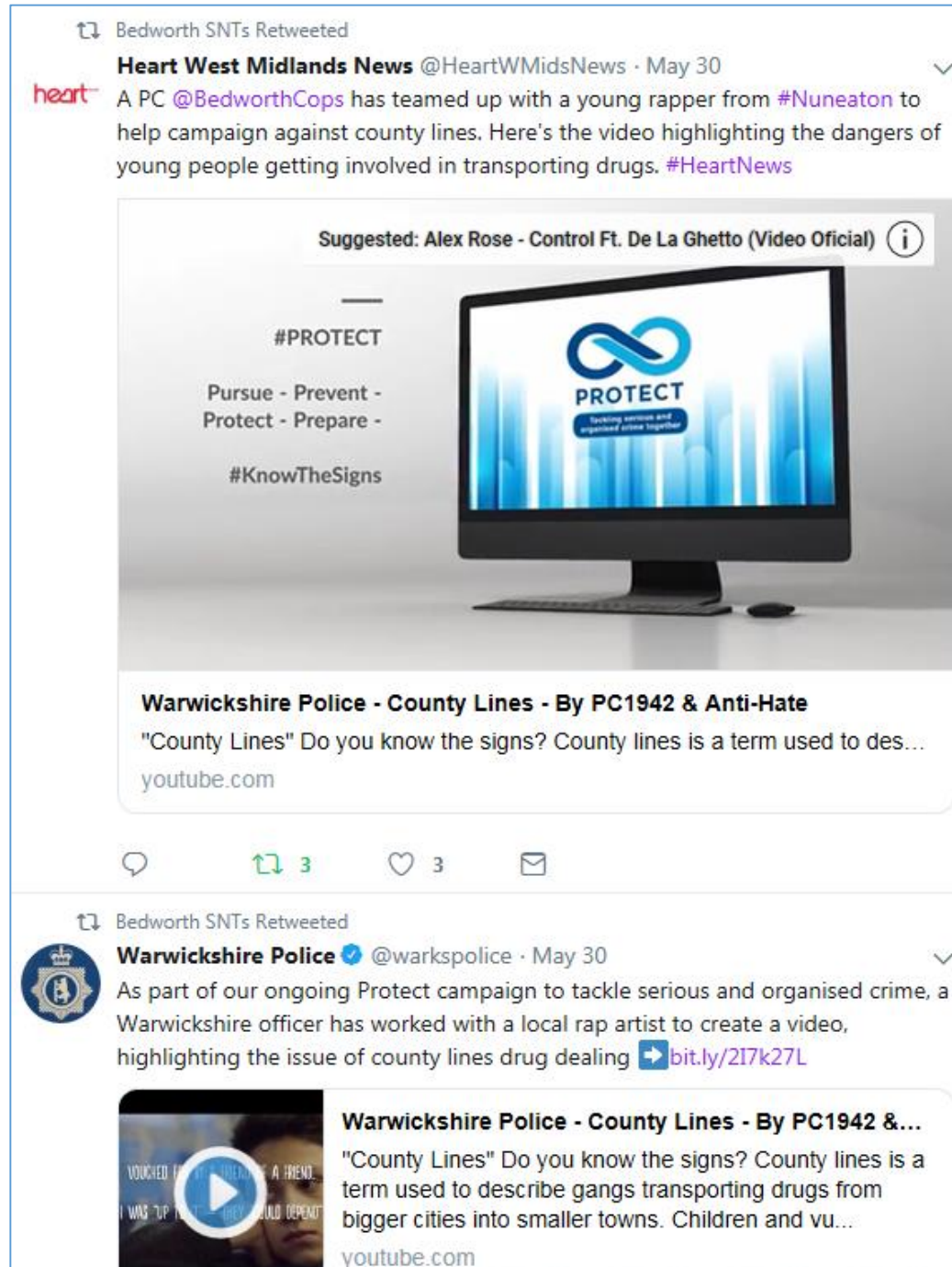
