

## LOCALITY WORKING

As part of a countywide approach to locality working, six localities were identified across Rugby Borough. These are geographical areas, each of which is served by a Community Forum. Forums are local public meetings, held quarterly and to which everyone is welcome to attend. The Forum meetings are attended by Councillors and officers from both the County and Borough Councils, as well as the Police through their local Safer Neighbourhood Team and representatives from the health sector.

To help support this way of working Locality Plans have been produced for the rural areas in the Borough in partnership with the local community, & local public, private, voluntary and community sector agencies. These Plans aim to provide the basis for a long-term resolution to priorities identified in the area, whilst at the same time improving the way agencies engage and involve local people in the decisions that are made about their community.

The **Dunchurch Division Locality Plan** forms an agreement between the local people living in the locality and the organisations delivering public services in the area. It will be refreshed each year, and will have its performance monitored by the local community at Community Forum meetings. The Plan is a live document so the problems and solutions identified can be changed as the Plan is reviewed and refreshed.
