People are parking too close to the Junction at Barbridge Road.	Police agreed to investigate.
School bus and parking on Zig Zags when dropping off and picking up from St James Junior School, Barbridge Road.	Police to investigate.
New Double Yellow signs on Leicester Road – does this need a sign for enforcement?	Confirm with Highways if a sign is needed.
The forum request that they would like a breakdown of Civil Parking visits and penalty notices just for Bulkington please for the next forum.	Request to be passed to the Civil Enforcement Team.
Coventry Road, Pauls Land: litter and rubbish all around.	NBBC Simone Donaghy to investigate with NBBC officers.
Most bus stops in Bulkington Village are not accessible – it is impossible to use if in a wheelchair or motorised chair as they are sloped or on grass	Pass to WCC Highways to investigate.
