Priority One

To carry out a minimum of 12 high visibility patrols on Shilton Industrial Estate, Shilton, with a view to detecting and deterring burglary and other offences.

22 recorded visits conducted. No offences reported

Priority Two

To carry out a minimum of 6 speed detection operations in Main Street and Rugby Road, Clifton-upon-Dunsmore

6 operations conducted. 1085 vehicles checked, 18 in excess of the 30mph. Warning letters sent to offending vehicles.

SNT News & Community Engagement

Parking Patrols outside of all the schools on the area conducted. Advice given to parents. 8 drivers issued with penalty notices for obstructing the highway.

Speed checks conducted at Monks Kirby at the start of school to highlight speeding through the village to parents.

2 persons arrested in connection with theft from building sites and farmyards.

The team is still working to increase the use of Neighbourhood Watch and Rural Watch
