## Community Priority One

**To carry out a minimum of 15 high visibility patrols in the area of Newbold Quarry Park Rugby with a view to detecting and deterring offences of Anti-Social behaviour.**

### Result

**16 Dedicated patrols conducted around the Newbold Quarry Park.**

**On one occasion two males were arrested following enquiries into anti-social behavior.**

## Community Priority Two

**To conduct a minimum of 15 high visibility patrols around the shops and public areas off Hollowell Way Brownsover to detect and deter offences of Anti social behaviour during evenings and weekends.**

### Result

**16 Dedicated patrols conducted around the shopping area on Hollowell Way, no anti – social behaviour incidents recorded however on one occasion PC KETLEY moved on a large group of youths who were starting to congregate around the shops.**

## Community Priority Three

To conduct a minimum of 15 patrols around the retail stores close to Projects Drive and Boughton Road to detect and deter offences of Anti social behaviour and suspected drug usage / dealing taking place during the day, evenings and weekends.

### Result

15 Dedicated patrols conducted in the area. Numerous calls regarding nuisance motor bikes on the Boughton Road and Butlers Leap area. A section 59 warning was issued to one rider and another mini-motor was seized as a result.
