The role of the Learning Disability Reps



- To meet with customers of Warwickshire County Council and seek views and opinions about services.



- To seek the views and opinions of people with a learning disability about progress made towards the action plans.



- Monitor the progress towards the action plans.



- Help to make the information from the partnership Board accessible for people with a Learning Disability.



- Take part in selecting new board members.



- To act as a 'Partnership Board Buddy' when required.



- Lead 'small working groups' when required.

The responsibilities of the Learning Disability Rep



- To attend all Partnership Board Meetings, or send a representative.



- To keep people interested and committed and gain trust of all people with an interest in learning disabilities and the Partnership Board.



- Together with other board members to represent and raise awareness of the Warwickshire Partnership Board at events and activities as agreed with the Board.



- Check how well the partnership board is doing as a member. Is the Partnership Board making a difference?
